

**FCAVC CRIMINAL JUSTICE ADVISORY COMMITTEE**  
**SCHOLARSHIP AWARD**  
**Rules and Regulations**

**I. ELIGIBILITY**

- A. Graduating seniors who have completed the Four County Area Vocational Cooperation Criminal Justice Program will be considered. Juniors are encouraged to apply next year.
- B. Should be scholastically capable of college or vocational work.
- C. Must attend an accredited college, university or trade school.

**II. OPERATING RULES**

- A. The amount of this scholarship will be an outright grant for one year only. (Non-renewable)
- B. Students must fulfill all the requirements of the applications in order to have the application considered.
- C. This scholarship will be determined by the Program Advisory Committee and will be disbursed by the same.
- D. This money will be applied towards educational expenses only at the school of the student's choice in the name of the student and school.

**III. MISCELLANEOUS**

- A. Student's qualifications and scholastic standing will be reviewed prior to awarding the scholarship.

- C. Selection of the student(s) will be made by the Program Advisory Committee.
- D. Any unusual circumstance or questions of default will be reviewed by the Committee.
