

FOUR COUNTY AREA VOCATIONAL COOPERATIVE



Effective May 9, 2011, GED Testing Centers, including Four County Area Vocational Cooperative, will no longer be allowed to issued duplicate GED transcripts or GED diplomas.

The State of Indiana has issued the following statement:

Official transcripts are now standardized, printed on security/non-copy paper, and can be made available for electronic viewing by employment verification firms and postsecondary institutions.

Diploma Sender is a service of Lilac, LLC, and Indiana's selected provider for GED document fulfillment services. Individuals can begin ordering duplicate GED documents from Diploma Sender TODAY. To order GED documents, navigate to:

Institutions wanting verification of a GED will need to have their candidates/applicants register on www.diplomasender.com and direct the verification accordingly.
